

THE PERCY LANHAM BURSARY

Percy A. Lanham was a retired educator, having graduated from the Normal School in 1936, with a Certificate of Education. He graduated from The University of Manitoba with a Bachelor of Arts (Honours) in 1934 and a Master of Arts in 1935. He taught in a number of rural schools before becoming a vice-principal and then principal in the Brooklands School District from 1941 to 1955. He then taught junior high school at several institutions in Winnipeg, including Laura Secord (1955 – 1960), Gordon Bell (1960 – 1969) and General Wolfe (1969 -1975). He was also very active in coaching and organizing sports programs both within and outside of the school system. He is particularly noted for his efforts in track and field and speed skating.

Percy was very appreciative of the financial assistance that he received from the Imperial Order of the Daughters of the Empire, during his post-secondary education. Without their support, he would have been unable to continue his education. Percy felt it was his privilege to be in a position to help other students in financial need. Accordingly, he established The Percy Lanham Foundation Inc., a registered charitable private foundation, to provide bursaries to qualifying candidates.

The board of the Foundation shall in each year award one or more bursaries at each of the six main post-secondary institutions in the province, namely The University of Manitoba, The University of Winnipeg, Brandon University, Red River Community College, University College of the North, and Assiniboine Community College. The number and size of the bursaries shall be in the sole discretion of the board of the Foundation, in keeping with the funds available, but it is intended that the bursaries shall be a substantial contribution to the tuition, book and supply costs of the recipients, and, if possible, to their living expenses.

The bursaries shall be available to students who:

1. Have completed without condition one or more years of study in a first undergraduate degree or diploma program, **earning a minimum of 24 credit hours in the previous year of study.**
2. Proceed in the next ensuing academic year to the next year in their program with a full course load. **The minimum requirement is 24 credit hours.**

The board shall judge the applicants based upon financial need, scholastic results, extra-curricular activities, and such other criteria as the board considers meritorious. The successful candidates shall be entirely in the board's discretion.

Applications should be returned to the Foundation **together with Official transcripts** by July 15th, annually. Applications with official transcripts will be assessed in early August. Applications may be mailed to:
